RPB Type C Installation Overview

The following is a brief description of the installation procedures associated with the Type C rudder port/bearing. Installation instructions are included with each unit and should be followed closely.

- Insert the Type-C into the tube. Using the hole 3.
 pattern in the flange of the unit as a template,
 drill thruholes in the tube flange for mounting.
- 2. Remove the unit and prepare the tube for bonding by wiping the inside clean of any dust or construction debris.
- 3. Using a medium-bodied, filled epoxy or Chock fast®, coat the barrel of the Type-C. In addition, lay a bead of marine sealant (such as Lifecaulk™ or 3M™ 101) under the flange at the top of the Type C barrel.
- 4. Insert the Type-C into the tube and secure in position using appropriately-sized SS hex head bolts. Do not undersize hardware. Use flat and lock washers as necessary.

NOTE: Before installing the rudder, insert the red installation hat into the lip seal. When rudder is in place, remove, invert and replace it on top of the Type C unit to keep debris off the lip seal during use.
